

Europa in der Zangengeburt: Bidens Zeit läuft ab

US-Präsident Biden reist kurz nach Deutschland und betont dringenden Bedarf an Unterstützung für die Ukraine vor den Wahlen 2024.

Berlin, Deutschland - US President Joe Biden made a fleeting but impactful visit to Berlin on Friday, using every moment to showcase his commitment to supporting Ukraine and addressing Middle Eastern issues before leaving office in January. During this visit, he received Germany's highest honor, the special class of the Grand Cross, from German President Frank-Walter Steinmeier. Biden emphasized the urgency of continued assistance to Ukraine amidst the ongoing conflict, stating, "We must sustain our support until Ukraine wins a just and durable peace."

As tensions escalate, Biden's stop in Germany also highlighted concerns about the future of US military aid. With the November elections looming, uncertainty hangs over America's foreign policy direction, especially against the backdrop of Trump's past administration, which was marked by strained NATO relations. Meanwhile, German Chancellor Olaf Scholz faces rising domestic pressures, and despite promises of military reform, bureaucratic hurdles are hindering substantial progress. While NATO powers reaffirmed their determination to back Ukraine, the urgency for clear commitments and additional resources remains high, especially as Ukraine finds itself increasingly vulnerable in the ongoing war with Russia.
