

Harris wechselt von Freude zu Faschist für Trump

Kamala Harris beschreibt Trump als "Faschisten" und warnt vor dessen Machtstreben. Ein Strategiewechsel für die Wahl 2024.

Washington DC, USA - In a fierce speech outside the vice-presidential residence in Washington DC, Kamala Harris took aim at Donald Trump, branding him as "increasingly unhinged and unstable." Citing John Kelly, Trump's former Chief of Staff, she marked him as a potential fascist and claimed he seeks "unchecked power." When pressed during a CNN Town Hall on whether she views him as a fascist, Harris replied emphatically, "Yes, I do." This sharp critique comes amid escalating tensions as the 2024 presidential race heats up, grabbing headlines and sparking immediate backlash from the Trump campaign, which dismissed her statements as desperate lies.

As both candidates ramp up their attacks, Harris's strategy appears focused on swaying independent voters and moderate Republicans, a tough challenge given the deeply entrenched opinions on Trump. Polls indicate a tightly contested race, necessitating a strong appeal to disenchanted voters in key battleground regions. Harris plans to further amplify her message in upcoming rallies, including one in Texas, emphasizing the dangers of a Trump presidency on issues like abortion rights and healthcare. Meanwhile, Trump amplified his own criticisms of Harris, calling her "lazy" and questioning her abilities, while warning of dire consequences should she win.
