

Sélestat verschenkt Punkte gegen Cournon: Spannung bis zur letzten Sekunde!

Sélestat und Cournon trennen sich mit 28-28. Sélestat verliert wichtige Punkte, trotz Kampfgeist in den letzten Minuten.
