

Studentenführer Paing Phyo Min in Myanmar festgenommen - Angst um sein Leben!

Myanmar: Sicherheitskräfte verhafteten den prominenten Studentenführer Paing Phyo Min in Yangon während einer nächtlichen Razzia.

In a dramatic nighttime raid, Myanmar security forces have apprehended Paing Phyo Min, a key student union leader and protest figure, in Yangon. This shocking arrest occurred in Thaketa township, with officials storming his residence. "We are very concerned about his life and safety," stated a member of the "Anti-junta Alliance Yangon" protest group, highlighting the risks associated with such high-profile detentions.

Paing Phyo Min, previously sentenced to six years in prison for a satirical poem mocking the military under Aung San Suu Kyi's government, was a prominent voice against the junta. Since the military coup in 2021, he has played a pivotal role in organizing pro-democracy protests, which have faced severe repression. The junta's crackdown has led to over 27,000 arrests, with reports of torture and deaths in custody surfacing since the coup. The situation remains tense as the military continues to suppress dissent in the bustling city of Yangon, where open challenges against their rule have been silenced.
